# Photos and Videos

Gather all the photographs and videos you have of the Events, trips and, most of all of the lesson made at local level.



# Interviews

Make video or written interviews to the participants to the International Workshops, talking about their experience, their perception of the European Union and what was their understanding of the Media Literacy and anti-fake news activity of the EU.



# Research

Research information about your National policies on the Fake News and Media Literacy Sector and about actions to contrast the diffusion of hoax.

Gather a list of websites that report information about what are the EU and national policies to support Citizens in tackling and contrasting fake news.



# Local Meeting

Organise a Local Meeting, open to the general public and inviting Public Authorities, schools and stakeholders.

During the conference you should report about the activities, promote Europe for Citizens Programme and debate actions for the contrast to fake news and incorrect use of socials.



# Expenditure Report

You should report on the travelling delegates, sending a list of the names of the participants to each International Workshop, together with documentation about the travel (flight tickets, highway tools and so on).

This will allow an easy reimbursement as agreed at the start of the project.
